This course is dedicated to the contemporary practices of Art & Science, with a focus on the directions and projects from the last 10 years. Each lecture starts with a review of the history of scientific discoveries, primarily from the 19th to the 21st centuries, directly related to the lecture's topic, as well as a brief excursion into the history of Art & Science, aimed at understanding the contemporary context. The course is practice-oriented, meaning the emphasis is on the fact that it is taught by an artist and curator specifically for artists. Special attention is given to artistic choice of Art & Science strategies, adaptive methods of representing works in various exhibition spaces, approaches to project documentation, and practical aspects of working with curators and festivals.
